

Foster Youth College Checklist

- Fill out your [FAFSA](#) and [California Chafee Grant for Foster Youth](#).
- Turn in [Foster Care Eligibility Certification Form](#) [PDF] to the Financial Aid Office, if required.
- Turn in your admissions application at the Admission Office (If you're still in high school, get a Concurrent Enrollment Form from your principal.)
- Get your school to submit your GPA electronically; if they cannot, get the **paper** [Cal Grant GPA Verification form](#) [PDF].
- Take assessment tests at the Assessment Center.
- Turn in Board of Governors ([BOG](#)) Fee Waiver Application to the Financial Aid Office.
- Turn in the Extended Opportunity Programs and Services (EOPS) Application to the EOPS Office.
- Get class schedule and catalog from the bookstore & sign up for orientation.
- Make an appointment in the Counseling Center.
- Use the schedule and catalog to register for classes.
